Entering grades 1-4

Botanical Immersion Session N | Jun 20-Jul 3

Sport: Swimming, Ice Skating and Rock Climbing

Discover a whole new way of seeing the world around you with this Botanical Immersion experience! From the protozoa in our Japanese garden to the ancient oak tree, our school is full of botanical interests. The creative process of growing and harvesting a garden will be central to our theme of native plant Botany. The session will conclude with a lunch celebration for children and their parents. Master Artists and Masterpieces Session O | Jul 9-20

Sport: Swimming, Ice Skating and Soccer

Nurture the artist within your child! Students will explore great works of art by master artists such as Van Gogh, Picasso, O'Keefe, Monet and Pollack. Hands-on, creative experiences will foster your child's understanding of basic principles of art. Best of all, children will have wonderful environments to create their own masterpieces — whether in our beautiful brand-new art studio or *plein-air* painting in our garden courtyard. Outdoor Literacy and Hiking Exploration Session P | Jul 23-Aug 3

Sport: Swimming, Hiking and Introduction to Archery

Students will experience the basics of outdoor literacy by learning to read a topographical map, using a compass, identifying edible wild plants, and creating a first aid kit to treat poison ivy, sunburn, and insect bites. They will also learn to "read" the woods for signs of birds, amphibians and mammals while walking and hiking the school grounds and visiting nature centers. Hiking excursions include day trips to Bowman's Wildflower Preserve and the Delaware Canal (weather permitting). Led by Sally Luke.

Pop into Fun! The Art of Pop-Up Books Session Q | Aug 6-10

Sport: Swimming, Tae Kwon Do and Backyard Games

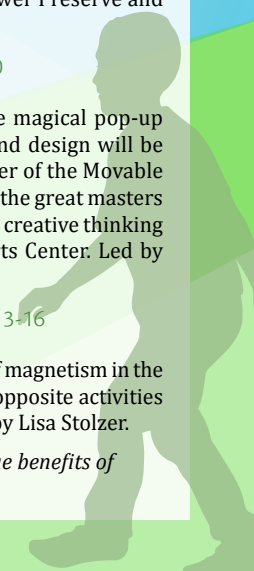
